THE PROGRAM

The New Beginning Initiative helps hardworking families achieve self-sufficiency by removing key barriers to employment, including transportation, childcare, and housing, empowering individuals to build stable, independent, and financially secure futures.

WHO QUALIFIES

- Available to Lake County residents.
- Must be employed full time, with a work history or in an accredited educational program or trade school. If in an educational program, applicants should be working part-time, at minimum.
- Provide needed documentation to meet financial and nonfinancial criteria.
- Complete regular check-ins and document review with program coordinator.
- Applicants may qualify for multiple forms of assistance. Each form of assistance may be used once.
- The New Beginning Initiative is a privately funded program that supports individuals who do not qualify for federal assistance.
- All programs are dependent on funding and eligibility requirements.

AVAILABLE SERVICES



CHILD CARE

The program may offer assistance with child care.



TRANSPORTATION

Including assistance with gas, car repairs, and rides to and from work.



HOUSING ASSISTANCE

Including assistance with either rent or mortgage.



EDUCATION

Including GED, college degree, or vocational studies.
